

Selectmen's Meeting
January 20, 2010

1. A model holding tank ordinance was submitted by Terry Lowd for the Selectmen's consideration. The ordinance, which would be enforced by the Plumbing Inspector, could bring additional revenues to the Town. A public hearing and Town Meeting vote is required to adopt an ordinance. The Selectmen are not in favor of the ordinance.
2. Reviewed and approved special entertainment permit applications.
3. Discussed the Shellfish Conservation Ordinance in general. A public hearing will be held on the proposed amendments which were reviewed by the area biologist.
4. A motion was made by Tibbetts to accept the renewal Shellfish Warden Service agreement with the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office. The motion was seconded by Yates and carried 3-0.
5. Reviewed and signed request for background check.
6. An extension of the snow removal contract was requested by the current contractor. Selectmen will consider the request early in 2011 when the contract expires. Selectmen are also considering providing snow removal through the Town's own Public Works department.
7. Reviewed tax acquired property.
8. Reviewed and approved disbursement warrants for the week.
9. Discussed 2010 budget.
