

Selectmen's Meeting
February 6, 2008

Present: *Chad Hanna, Bob Tibbetts, Paul Yates*
Also present: *Phil Congdon, Phil Crocker*

1. A public hearing was held concerning a permit application for a dock submitted by Cornelia Baxter. There was no public comment.
2. Building permit: Baxter, tax map 12 lot 8-3, 110-07/08, approved.
3. Talked with Phil Crocker about change to Fish House. The structure is in the flood plain. The flood plain permit requires a \$150.00 fee. Crocker has an issue with the amount of the fee. He would like the board to investigate why the \$150.00 fee is necessary.
4. Reviewed MDOT project request letter. Tibbetts will study and report at the next meeting.
5. Reviewed correspondence from Erv Snyder relative to the Simard case. A motion was made by Tibbetts to allow Snyder to resolve the case in accordance with the letter dated February 6, 2008 from Attorney Cohen to Snyder. The motion was seconded by Yates and carried 3-0.
6. Building permit: Slabaugh, tax map 15 lot 12, 53-07/08, approved.
7. Reviewed amendments to the Land Use Ordinance. The ordinance is ready to go; no further changes are necessary.
8. Discussed a request to remove the fees from the Shellfish Conservation Ordinance. Fees would be made part of the Town fee schedule. A motion was made by Hanna to remove the fee structure from the ordinance and place it on the Town fee schedule. The motion was seconded by Yates and carried 3-0.
9. Reviewed Attorney Hylie West's application for appeal to the law court in the matter of Cushing v. Town of Bristol.
10. Reviewed and approved reconciliations for the month of January.
11. Reviewed and approved disbursement warrants for the week.
