

Selectmen's Meeting
February 24, 2010

1. Discussed allegation that the Town Truck was used to sand private driveways on December 17, 2007. A cancelled check made out to John Prior was presented to the Selectmen. The parties involved have been asked about the incident and indicated that the person who drives the Town Truck sanded the driveways. It was not while he was working for the Town and he used John Prior's truck.
2. Discussed proposal from Pemaquid Group of Artists for use of the Art Gallery building at Lighthouse Park. Selectmen would agree to a three year contract with an escape clause for either party. They will request paperwork showing the gallery's non-profit status. The Parks Department will maintain the panels. The artists will also be responsible for half of the monthly electric bill. Liability insurance naming the Town of Bristol as additional insured must be held by the artists. Selectmen will request \$70 per artist the first year and \$90 per artist thereafter.
3. Reviewed and approved application for abatement submitted by the Round Pond Schoolhouse Assoc. for tax year 2009.
4. Reviewed and approved application for catered function submitted by Belle Fete Events and Catering for a September 5th event.
5. Reviewed and signed background check.
6. A request for endorsement of the Lincoln County Regional Planning Commission (LCRPC) was tabled.
7. Reviewed miscellaneous correspondence.
8. Reviewed and approved minutes of February 17, 2010.
9. Reviewed and approved disbursement warrants for the week.
10. Tibbetts agreed to contact the Department of Transportation concerning the condition of the Harrington Road. Selectmen plan to include Riverview Road in this year's maintenance program.
