

Selectmen's Meeting
April 9, 2008

1. Opened and reviewed Benner Road tree removal bids. Hanna moved to accept the bid submitted by Asplundh Tree Removal Experts Co. in the amount of \$38,675. The motion was seconded by Yates and carried 2-0.
2. Phinney and Prior requested the Selectmen's consideration of the Beach Loop Road proposal submitted by Phinney March 31, 2008. Yates requested contact with Linkas prior to making a decision. Hanna agreed that Linkas' consent would be preferred even though the guy wires are within the Town right of way. A letter will be sent to Linkas and the matter will be placed on next week's meeting agenda.
3. Jim Buckingham's resignation as Animal Control Officer was accepted.
4. Reviewed and approved appointments to the Fish Committee.
5. Discussed closure of Bristol's clam flats. Shellfish Committee members completed training and conducted shoreline survey work in an effort to assist the Department of Marine Resources in opening the flats as soon as possible. Compensation requested by Jen Casad and Dave Cheney was approved. South Bristol is expected to contribute 50% of the total.
6. Selectmen approved removal of winter road postings.
7. Road crew will be asked to fill holes on Morrison and Sproul Hill Roads. Spring grading will go out to bid next week.
