

Selectmen's Meeting May 7, 2008

1. The Shapiros presented a flood permit and building permit to be included with their application for a dock permit. A public hearing was scheduled for Wednesday May 21st at 7:00 pm.
2. Reviewed and approved catering permit for Maurer & Partners dba King Eiders Pub.
3. Discussed miscellaneous road issues:
 - ✓ An invitation to bid for Benner Road prep will be placed in next week's issue of the Lincoln County News. It appears at this time that 4 culverts need to be replaced in addition to 4 new culverts. Blasting should be done at Town line. A walk through meeting with interested contractors will be scheduled for Wednesday May 21st at 6:15 pm.
 - ✓ Culverts on the Morrison Road should be compacted if Marriner plans to pave right away.
 - ✓ Discussed storm damage in general. Ron Pendleton surveyed the damage with a representative from FEMA.
 - ✓ Selectmen plan to build up the Rock Schoolhouse Road this year. Once that project is complete, smaller projects may be scheduled as the budget allows.
 - ✓ Pemaquid Trail needs to be cold patched or paved.
4. Reviewed and approved special entertainment permit for Jennifer Chadwick.
5. Discussed making initial improvements to Town Hall. Selectmen plan to go out to bid for a new ADA compliant restroom in the near future. Also discussed a fire exit and partitioning off a room in the attic for file storage.
