

Selectmen's Meeting
May 28, 2008

1. Reviewed and approved application for special catering permit submitted by Maurer & Partners Corp. dba King Eiders Pub.
2. Opened and reviewed bids for the Benner Road ditching project. A motion was made by Yates to accept the bid submitted by Hanley Construction in the amount of \$54,800. The motion was seconded by Tibbetts and carried 2-0.
3. Reviewed and signed the 2008 tax commitment.
4. Discussed maintenance of Rock Schoolhouse Road and Split Rock Road. Holmes will be asked to grade the Rock Schoolhouse Road as soon as possible. Rusty Bryant will be asked to rip rap on Split Rock Road.
5. Discussed the possibility of adding a part-time person to assist with roads. A motion was made by Tibbetts to run an ad in the paper. The motion was seconded by Yates and carried 2-0.
6. Reviewed and signed consent agreement for Stack and Cieslinski, tax map 4C lot 5-1A.
7. Building permits:

 - Maxim, tax map 9 lot 73, 28-08/09, approved
 - Clark, tax map 22 lot 15, 29-08/09, approved
8. Reviewed memo from Code Enforcement provided for informational purposes only.
9. Discussed the status of the Shellfish Committee in general. Tibbetts suggested setting up a joint meeting with South Bristol.
10. Reviewed and approved minutes of May 21, 2008.
11. Reviewed and approved disbursement warrants for the week.
12. Tibbetts reported that Bristol will likely receive FEMA funds for road damage resulting from the recent storm.
13. Entered executive session pursuant to 1 M.R.S.A. § 405 (6) (F) to discuss an application for concealed firearms permit.
14. Approved concealed firearms permit for William Edward Benner.
