

**Selectmen's Meeting
September 5, 2007**

1. Bob Tibbetts gave an update on the Pemaquid Point Art Gallery. Information found was turned over to Jon LeVein. Selectmen agreed there needs to be a formal agreement between the Town & the Pemaquid Group of Artists. Bob also updated work in progress on various roads in town.
2. Howard Fraser asked permission to clean out a blocked culvert between his property and Split Rock Rd. He was directed to contact the DEP re. permits before any work is done. He was told he did not need a permit to erect a fence bordering his property, the former Penny Adams house on Bristol Rd..
3. The Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept Marriner Paving bids for Moxie Cove intersection/Upper Round Pond Rd intersection, Lower Round Pond Rd (shim coat), Pemaquid Harbor Rd (shim coat), & Moxie Cove intersection.
4. Reviewed DEP approval for extension of time at Partridge Bridge.
5. Discussed a letter from Mary Levitt re. property of Helen Bang near Partridge Bridge. They would like silky dogwoods used as part of the landscaping after bridge work is completed.
6. Building Permits for Harborfront Land Trust & Andrew Leck were returned unsigned – distances to property lines were incomplete.
7. Fire Warden appointments were signed.
8. "Letter of no objection" for septic work on Town land at Pemaquid Point was signed for Ralph Minor Lee, Trustee.
9. Disbursement warrants for the week were signed.
10. A letter from Lawrence P. Greenlaw, Jr. re. school consolidation was read and discussed. No further action will be taken.
11. Minutes of August 29, 2007 were approved.
