

Selectmen's Meeting
October 24, 2007

1. Discussed progress at Partridge Bridge in general.
2. Reviewed miscellaneous road issues: culverts on the Back Shore Road and Pemaquid Harbor Road will be reset; O.W. Holmes will repair Martha Beck Road; Marriners will pave at the Round Pond end of Upper Round Pond Road, Pemaquid Harbor Road and a shim coat in front of Masters Machine; Hagar will be asked to complete striping of the Lower Round Pond Road once the shim coat is done; O.W. Holmes will power grind the end of Sproul Hill Road to smooth out.
3. Todd Brackett met with Tibbetts and Poland concerning enforcement of Bristol's parking ordinance. The Town and the County may need to sign an agreement for "Parking Law Enforcement Services" as well. Enforcement will then be provided by the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office at no additional charge.
4. Signed Assessor Notification for Global Tower Partner.
5. Reviewed stipulated judgment in the matter of Shapiro v. Town of Bristol. Public access will be preserved to the water. A 10' x 20' area is excluded from public access although it is doubtful the Town ever had ownership of that parcel. The Selectmen agree with the judgment as written.
