1. There was a question concerning the salt shed door approved at the October 21st meeting. No changes will be made; the door will be ordered.
2. Discussed last week's snow blower purchase. Purchase was not approved by the Selectmen and the machine will be returned to the seller.
3. Round Pond Harbor's dredging project will be discussed at the next Harbor Committee meeting. The Selectmen may choose to present a warrant article at the March 2010 Town Meeting to appropriate funds for continuation of the Army Corps feasibility study.

5. Reviewed correspondence from Attorney Snyder concerning the McDowell property located on Moxie Cove Road. Discussed the possibility of making the dwelling habitable. The Town will request permission to enter the premises to evaluate.

7. Discussed beaver issues in general.
8. Parks Commissioners will meet with the Selectmen the 1st Wednesday in December to discuss the status of the Town's agreement with the Pemaquid Group of Artists, who will meet with the Selectmen the 2nd Wednesday in December.
