

**Selectmen's Meeting**  
**November 14, 2007**

Present: *Chad Hanna, Bob Tibbetts, Paul Yates, Kristine Poland*  
Also present: *Sandee Brackett, Phil Congdon*

1. A petition for assessment review was received in the matter of Norman and Sandra Brackett v. Town of Bristol. The matter was tabled until the Selectmen have had an opportunity to review the packet. Erv Snyder will be asked to assist in the process.
2. Reviewed proposed 2008 State valuation.
3. Discussed the possibility of conducting a revaluation in 2009. Selectmen prefer to review next year's sales analysis before making the decision to reevaluate.
4. A letter was received from New Harbor Cemetery Association requesting support of \$10.00 per veteran's grave. A list of 155 veterans was provided. Hanna moved to approve the request. The motion was seconded by Tibbetts and carried 3-0.
5. Reviewed request from the Department of Environmental Protection to reconsider the Slabaugh appeal.
6. Reviewed letter from the Department of Environmental Protection concerning inspection of the closed landfill. No concerns were cited.
7. The Selectmen were notified of a real estate collection error involving property of Barbara Hanna. The Tax Collector has been unable to contact Ms. Hanna.

9. Discussed discrepancy between John Tilton's Parks Department wages (\$12.50/hour) and Town wages (\$11.00/hour). Hanna moved to pay Mr. Tilton \$12.00 per hour during the two months he works for the Town. The motion was seconded by

- Yates and carried 3-0. It was noted that Tilton is a seasonal employee who receives no benefits, including holiday pay.

  11. Reviewed and approved disbursement warrants for the week.
  12. Reviewed and approved minutes of October 24, 2007 and October 31, 2007.
