

**Selectmen's Meeting
November 28, 2007**

Present: *Chad Hanna, Bob Tibbetts, Paul Yates, Kristine Poland*

Also present: *Sandee Brackett, Phil Congdon, David Lash, Celia Cart, Tom Penniman, School Committee, Bob Bouchard, Bobbi Swiderek*

1. A public hearing was held on an application for building permit submitted by Schroeder, tax map 5A lot 3 to construct a dock, runway and float. There was no public comment. Hanna declared the hearing closed.
2. Approved Schroeder building permit, tax map 5A lot 3, 90-07/08.
3. Discussed building permit issued to Penniman, tax map 31 lot 74, 42-05/06. The permit, which was signed more than a year ago, was issued for a foundation and made note of a 'future cottage'. Penniman indicated that office staff told him that he was all set because an initial start was made on construction. It appears that it was Penniman's intent to construct the cottage based on the original permit application. Hanna moved to allow building to continue under this permit with no other considerations. The motion was seconded by Yates and carried 3-0.
4. Bristol's School Committee is submitting an incomplete plan for regionalization. Bouchard stated that nearly every aspect of the plan has not been agreed upon. All parties are still at the table and will see the process through. The School Committee voted to submit, but not endorse the plan. At this time, it would appear that a vote will not occur until November 2008; we need to wait and see what the Legislature will do. Petitions to overturn school consolidation need to be turned into the State prior to January 28, 2008. Fifteen thousand certified signatures were collected as of the November 2007 election, fifty thousand are required. The next meeting of the RPC will be held January 15th.
5. Pine State Safety will be back to stripe the Lower Round Pond Road. Restitution to Bristol Fire & Rescue to clean up paint will be deducted from the invoice. Citizens will be reimbursed only for a standard car wash.
6. O.W. Holmes was unable to lay the 12" culvert at Martha Beck Road due to ledge at 10". They will be asked to relocate the culvert if they are able to find an adequate location. No ledge will be removed.
7. Signed letter to The Pemaquid Point Association addressing safety concerns.
8. Signed letter to the State Board of Assessment Review concerning Brackett v. Town of Bristol.
9. Signed letter of intent to Barba+ Wheelock.
10. Approved building permit for Gluchanicz, tax map 9 lot 98A, 107-07/08.
11. Reviewed and approved disbursement warrants for the week.
12. Reviewed and approved minutes of November 7, 2007 and November 14, 2007.
13. Reviewed miscellaneous correspondence.
14. Warden Bragg will be asked to attend the Monday December 3rd meeting of the Shellfish Committee.
15. Tibbetts will check the condition of the culvert at the end of Bradley Hill Road.
