

Selectmen's Meeting
December 12, 2007

1. Reviewed request from Saltwater Artists Gallery for property tax exemption. While the gallery itself is a 501 (c) (3) organization, the artists are selling their work for profit. For this reason, Tibbetts moved to deny the request. The motion was seconded by Yates and carried 3-0.
2. Peter Hope submitted his resignation from the 'clam committee'. Tibbetts moved to accept his resignation. The motion was seconded by Yates and carried 3-0.
3. Reviewed correspondence from the State Board of Property Tax Review received in the matter of Brackett v. Town of Bristol and Hanna v. Town of Bristol. Poland will respond to the Brackett correspondence. Hanna will prepare a response to Hanna.
4. Reviewed file letters concerning the Elizabeth J. Bibber Trust. The appointment of the Town of Bristol as Trustee was made November 4, 1974. The Selectmen would like to see information concerning qualifications to receive assistance from the Trust. Poland will contact Cumberland County Probate for records concerning the Trust.
5. Selectmen are uncertain why the Town plows the State Park property. Matt Maguire, the Park's Manager, will be contacted concerning this matter.
