

**Selectmen's Meeting
December 16, 2009**

1. Bob Faunce, Lincoln County Planner, presented the draft Bicycle-Pedestrian Plan for Bristol. The plan reflects overall community attitudes and preferences of those who completed the survey. Priority recommendations include Route 130 from New Harbor to Pemaquid Point, Route 32 from Old Long Cove Road to Shaw's Wharf, and Route 32 from New Harbor to Chamberlain. Opportunities for improvement include, but are not limited to, lighting, signage, paved shoulders and trimming. If the plan is approved by the Selectmen, Faunce suggested that the Comprehensive Plan be amended to include the recommendations set forth in the plan. The Department of Transportation would then be required to consider pedestrian and bicycle improvements when they undertake road improvements in Town.
2. Reviewed and approved special entertainment permit for The 1812 Farm.
3. A motion was made by Hanna to approve an application for abatement submitted by Shannon, tax map 10 lot 43-12. The motion was seconded by Tibbetts and carried 3-0.
4. Reviewed and approved reconciliations for the month of November.
