

**Selectmen's Meeting
December 23, 2009**

1. Reviewed abatement submitted by Shannon, tax map 10 lot 43-12. A motion was made by Hanna to abate for 2008 and 2009 due to the circumstances. The motion was seconded by Tibbetts and carried 3-0.
2. Reviewed notice from the Department of Marine Services concerning a renewal aquaculture permit application submitted by David Cheney. The Selectmen had no comments.
3. Building permits:
 - Brinkler, tax map 7 lot 72F, revision approved
 - Hinson, tax map 23 lot 20A, revision approved
 - Smith, tax map 8 lot 11, revision approved
 - Loprieno/Lockhart, tax map 8 lot 37A-7, 73-09/10, approved
4. Reviewed memo from Code Enforcement provided for informational purposes only.
5. Discussed roads in general. Icing on the South Side Road appears to be a private issue, not the responsibility of the Town. The Maine Historic Preservation Commission was contacted concerning guardrails on the Benner Road stone arch bridge which were damaged by a plow truck. As long as Federal money is not involved, the Town can do maintenance work without restrictions resulting from the bridge's historic designation.
6. Reviewed and approved disbursement warrants for the week.
7. Discussed potential sale of tax acquired property situated at 305 Carl Bailey Road to the previous owner. A motion was made by Tibbetts to accept the amount of \$3,703.98 which includes estimated taxes and interest for 2009 and associated costs. The motion was seconded by Yates and carried 3-0.
8. Entered executive session pursuant to 1 M.R.S.A. § 405 (6) (A) to discuss the Town Administrator's contract.
