1. Reviewed correspondence from the Army Corps of Engineers concerning funding for continuance of the Round Pond dredging feasibility study. The Corps is requesting \$50,000 by March of 2008. We need to honor our budget process. Poland will contact the Corps for further information concerning the timing of payments by the Town and whether or not a later payment would break the project.
2. Reviewed correspondence from Barba + Wheelock concerning the Town Hall project. It would appear that the architect is requesting \$4,500 between now and Town Meeting. This is contrary to what was discussed at previous meetings. No action was taken by the Selectmen. A Town Hall Planning Committee meeting will be scheduled for Tuesday January 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm.
