- A. Submit a site plan at a scale of 1'' = 100' including:
 - 1. Property boundary lines;
 - 2. A report by a registered soil scientist of the soils on the property being suitable for an automobile graveyard or a junkyard;
 - 3. The location of any sand and gravel aquifer recharge areas as mapped by the Maine Geological Survey or a certified geologist;
 - 4. The location of any residence or school within 500 feet of where the cars will be stored;
 - 5. The location of any body of water or wetland on the property or within 200 feet of the property lines:
 - 6. The boundaries of the 100-year floodplain;
 - 7. The location and name of all roads within 1,000 feet of the site;
 - 8. A plan for containment of fluids, containment and disposal of batteries and storage or disposal of tires;
 - 9. The location within the property boundary lines where vehicles are drained, dismantled or stored;
 - 10. Location of any public or private water supply within 300 feet of the site;
 - 11. North arrow.
- B. Provide proof of mailing the notice of the application to all abutting property owners. (Abutting property includes land across a street or a right-of-way from the subject lot.)
- C. Provide proof that a notice of intent has been filed with the Department of Environmental Protection to comply with the general permit provisions for storm water discharges, or the D.E.P has determined that a storm water discharge permit is not required.
