Harbor Committee Bristol Town Hall January 26, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 pm.

Minutes.

On a motion made by Poland and seconded by Hope, the minutes from 10/27/2016 were approved unanimously.

Unregistered Moorings.

A list of unregistered moorings was circulated. After adjustments made by Harbormasters, a final list of unregistered moorings was prepared and reviewed. It was concluded that moorings are considered unregistered if the fee has not been paid and/or an application has not been filed.

Harbor Master Reports.

Ball reported a skiff sunk in the harbor due to the motor getting trapped. The owner was able to retrieve it. Ball is currently in possession of 2 skiffs and 1 kayak. He will post on the public notice board this summer. He asked that everyone keep an eye out for a green skiff that has been lost by a local resident. He noted that floats are being stored at the lupine field.

Hope reported quiet harbors.

Stolecki reported quiet harbors. He noted that an owner of a boat kept on its mooring yearround has been checking on it.

Hanna Landing.

Parks and Rec has asked the Harbor Committee to share the cost of a new 10 x 30 float. All agreed that Harbors would pitch in a certain percentage of the cost. Stolecki will talk to New Harbor Marine and C. Pendleton.

Ball wondered if bids would be required. Hanna said anything over \$10,000 required a bid but they could do a bid if they wanted.

The first three floats were built at the same time and the next two floats came later.

Meeting adjourned at 6:41 The next meeting will be held on April 27 @ 6 pm.
