Minutes

Student Licenses/Ordinance Amendments

There was brief discussion on the transitioning of student licenses to adult licenses when the student turns 18 and is no longer enrolled in school. Area biologist H. Annis has been contacted. She has referred the matter to Shellfish Management Director, D. Nault of DMR. The committee will wait for a response before moving forward with any ordinance changes.

Conservation

The committee awaits results from FB Environmental for DNA analysis of water samples taken over the summer months. Bizarro will contact them to find out when they are available for reporting their findings to the committee.

It was decided to not pursue any seed transplanting over the next few months.

The committee unanimously agreed to open the municipal closure in Pemaquid River (including Schoolhouse Cove) from January 1 to May 1, 2020.
