Amendments to the Agenda

Approval of Minutes

• A motion was made by Lowd to approve the minutes of May 4th. The motion was seconded by Yates and carried.

Tree Bids

 Opened and reviewed bids for Benner Road and Browns Cove Road tree work. A motion was made by Lowd to award the bids to Asplundh provided they will complete the work by June 17th. The motion was seconded by Yates and carried.

Solar Energy

• The school committee is considering converting to solar energy at Bristol School. ReVision Energy suggested installation of solar panels for a period of 6 years with the company receiving credit for energy production. The school would have the option to purchase the panels following the initial 6 year period. The next step is for the engineer to provide numbers for school officials to work with. The goal at this stage is to gather information. A decision has yet to be made regarding feasibility.
