

Budget Committee Meeting Minutes Monday February 6th, 2023 at 6:30 pm Bristol Town Office

The meeting was called to order by Paul Leeman, Chair of the Budget Committee, at 6:30pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Non-profits who have raised their requested amount from the previous year or who did not request any amount the previous year were required to present their budget to the committee. Leeman called for the non-profits to present their budget requests and presented in the following order:
