Minutes

Harbormaster Reports

Round Pond

Round Pond moorings have been seen for rent on Craig's List.

He contacted several mooring owners to let them know of the ordinance change that was voted on at Town Meeting this year. He has given these owners one season to decide if they are going to keep their mooring for personal use otherwise, they will need to give it up so it may be re-assigned to someone on his waiting list.

New Harbor

Peaceful. Hope noted that a piece of land with just a dock and a mooring is being foreclosed on.

Benner brought in a bag of float hardware that he picked up at New Harbor Landing. The crew of a local marine contractor had been building floats at the landing and did not pick up the debris when finished with the job.

Benner requested 5 "No Parking" signs for New Harbor landing.

Pemaquid

Stolecki reported that several moorings had been set without authorization of placement. He will talk to the marine contractor who placed them.

Contract at Hanna Landing

Stolecki confirmed that he authorized the 4 float connect brackets.

Miscellaneous

On a motion by Benner and seconded by Tedrow, it was unanimous approved to have the Chair and Vice Chair remain as before. Therefore John Stolecki is the Chair and David Caron is the Vice-Chair.
