

**Harbor Committee

The meeting was called to order at 6:13pm.

**New Harbor Mooring Usage.**

Davis/Henkin have purchased two waterfront properties. They requested to be added to the New Harbor waiting list. Hope will add them. Hope stated the next person on the list is a commercial shorefront owner. There are currently 4 recreational landowners on the list. About 12 out of 70 moorings in New Harbor are registered recreationally.

Hope informed them there was space in Long Cove. He thought an association fee may be charged for dock usage.

Davis/Henkin asked about amending the ordinance to remove the condition of commercial moorings remaining commercial. The committee unanimously agreed that presently it was not in the best interest of the town. If boat usage should change to mostly recreational vessels then the committee would consider amending it.

**Mooring Permit Fees.**

Rachel reviewed a delinquent mooring list with Harbormasters. Bills will be sent within the next few days.

**Minutes.**

The minutes from the 06/30/16 were approved unanimously with the following amendments: 2<sup>nd</sup> line in 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph under “New Harbor Mooring Usage”—added the word commercial before word mooring and 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph under “Mooring Permit Fees”—changed the word conservation to conversation.

**Harbor Master Reports.**

All reported quiet harbors. Ball stated he still has an unclaimed kayak.
