The meeting was called to order at 5:08.

Harbormaster reports.

Round Pond. After sending violation notices to two mooring owners who were illegally renting their moorings, Ball received feedback from both. If either of these moorings are being rented next year, Ball will follow through and seize the mooring and any boat on the mooring. Ball believes there are other moorings being rented. He hopes the word gets around and mooring owners realize they will lose their mooring if it continues to be rented. Ball reported a sunk boat that was pumped out and a lost skiff and outboard.

New Harbor. Not much going on, quiet.

Hanna Landing.

After discussion, Benner made a motion to request a two-year contract for the Hanna Landing floats. This was seconded by Ball and approved unanimously. Stolecki will talk to RPMS about this to see if an agreement can be made.

Miscellaneous.

The NHMC invoice remains unpaid. Stolecki reported to the committee his findings. The log was not taken to the Transfer Station as they were not accepting those types of items. It was suggested the log be brought to Toby Plummer for grinding. Stolecki will check with the Town Administrator about leaving the bill in arrears.
