The meeting was called to order at 6:09pm

Minutes

On a motion by Poland and seconded by Caron the minutes from September 19th were approved unanimously.

Harbormaster Reports

Reports were centered on a recent storm with high winds.

New Harbor

A 43' boat moved; it appeared the pennant parted off.

Hope reported the area that Parks created for float storage at the landing holds about 10 floats.

Pemaquid

Stolecki noted a couple of boats had moved.

Floats at Hanna Landing were still in the water. It was noted that repair work needed to be done where the ramp and pier connect. Round Pond Marine will be asked to look at it when they remove the ramp for winter storage.

Round Pond

Ball reported 3 boats broke loose during the storm. The following day a skiff sunk, and a sailboat broke loose.

A written proposal was submitted for leasing Thompson Landing. On a motion by Caron and seconded by Hope all agreed to send the proposal with recommendation to the Selectmen for approval. Bizarro reported that there is currently no map/lot assigned to that landing.

2020-21 Mooring Application

Changes include: draw more attention to "mooring # must appear on mooring buoy", add a line for who "inspected by" and their contact info, move clerical recording information.
