## Minutes:

#### Floats:

The float haulers attended the meeting at Pendleton's request. Discussion surrounded the need for cooperation between the Parks department and the haulers to make the process smoother and more efficient. Peters now has a list of float owners from all the haulers and will be sending out the last of the float letters for the 2015-2016 payments. The haulers understand the importance of sharing the landing area with the public so they can enjoy the space as well.

As long as the haulers can keep the floats neat and orderly they will not be required to stack them. There is a need for more gravel at Hanna Landing as it is difficult for the haulers to maneuver due to the softness of the ground in certain places.

Pendleton described the new policy where all the floats will be re-numbered with the identification being burnt into the float. There was a disagreement regarding withholding the float hauling services until the Parks received their float storage fee. Further discussion on this will be tabled for future meetings.

Open Lighthouse Day is Saturday September 10<sup>th</sup>. No band is going to perform, however there will be hamburgers and hot dogs will be sold.
