- 1. Minutes of Meeting of January 15, 2019. Richard Francis brought attention to the fact that Belinda of Old Bristol Historical Society mentioned they "may indeed request future grants." Vote to amend the minutes 7-2-2
- 2. Bristol / South Bristol Transfer Station David Poland, Manager
  Noted that amount of incoming trash at the station increases every year, increasing
  expenses. Also there is a need for an additional employee in the summer season.

- **3.** Bristol Parks & Recreation Lara Sargent, Parks Director & Commissioners 2018 Expenses and 2019 Budget were presented. The Beach Pavilion project is on hold while waiting for a grant. Explanation that a Capital Reserve account is needed for protection in the event of a season of low income. **12-0**
- Bristol Fire & Rescue Paul Leeman Jr., Fire Chief
   2018 Expenses and 2019 Budget were presented. A discrepancy between the Warrant for Town Meeting and Fire Budget sheets was found, which will need to be adjusted and approved by the Selectmen. 11-0-1
