## APPLICATION FOR ANNUAL BRISTOL PARKS PASS



An individual may qualify for a Bristol parks season pass if they are:

1. A Bristol resident
2. A Bristol real estate taxpayer
3. A Bristol personal property taxpayer
4. A dependent of the above (ages 12-18)

A Bristol resident may prove residency by showing a driver's license or utility/phone bill in his/her name with a Bristol address.

A Bristol real estate taxpayer proves property ownership by being listed as a taxpayer in the Annual Report or by showing a Bristol real estate tax bill mailed to his/her home address.

Children 12 to 18 qualify for a season pass if their parents qualify.

Possession of an expired pass does not automatically qualify a person for a new pass.
